Auburn Public Library WiFi Hotspot Policy

- A hotspot may be borrowed for a three week period. It may be renewed once ONLY
 if no one is waiting for it.
- Checkout is limited to 1 per household.
- It is the policy of APL to lend out WiFi hotspots to all eligible Library customers over the age of 18. Eligible customers are defined as those possessing an Auburn or Lewiston library record in good standing (no billed items, and up-to-date contact information).
- The borrower is responsible for any loss or damage and is subject to replacement costs (\$40) if the device is returned with damage that renders it inoperable or if it is not returned. (\$20 for the device/\$10 for charger and cable/\$10 for carrying case). Wireless service will be discontinued if the hotspot is overdue.
- All hotspot use must conform to Auburn Public Library's Internet Use Policy.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for hotspots used by underage patrons.
- The Library is not responsible for any liability, damages, or expense resulting from use or misuse of the device, connection of the device to other electronic devices, or data loss resulting from use of device.
- Hotspots must be returned to the library during regular business hours with all parts.
